Antigal UNO Red Blend 2019 is an alluring combination of varietals made from grapes hand-harvested in our Uco Valley vineyards. The grape clusters were immediately refrigerated and double-sorted upon arrival at the winery, where our gravity-fed technology allowed for soft vinification that protected the freshness and aromatic character of the fruit.

TASTING NOTES

"The wine shows a ruby red and violet color of medium intensity. The nose is very fresh and fruit-driven with notes of black and red fruits such as plum. Notes of mint, camphor, white pepper, graphite, and vanilla are all evident. Tannins are silky, almost velvety, and well-rounded; the balance is very good and there is a touch of wood from oak-aging on the finish."
